

FSEHD Spring 2017 Admissions

The online application screen will be active from November 18, 2016 to January 9, 2017

Check the completion status of your FSEHD admission requirements in by logging into the **MyRIC** portal account and selecting **FSEHD APPL Requirements** (under Other Student Links).

If each box **is checked** – you will be able to apply for admission while the online application screen is active. Once all boxes are checked go to **Apply For FSEHD** (also in MyRIC), choose your major, and select **SAVE**.**

If a box **is not checked**, see the **Requirements for Admissions** for detailed admissions requirements.

Core, SAT, ACT

- If your test scores (Core, SAT, ACT) meet the requirement, the tests will be checked in the appropriate box (in MyRIC).
- If you have a passing score report that was not sent to RIC – bring a hard copy to Mrs. Grady in HM 105.
- If you have not yet taken any test you can register for the Core tests (<http://www.ets.org/praxis/about/core>) and have scores sent to Rhode Island College (**Code R3724**) – it takes about three weeks for RIC to receive those scores.

Completion of at least 24 credits

- This includes transfer credits – contact Admissions Office if you believe transfer credit was not awarded.

Minimum GPA of 2.75

- Your admission cannot be approved without the appropriate Cumulative GPA from courses taken at RIC.
- If you are a transfer student and believe you have completed all other requirements see your academic advisor.

B- or better in FNED 346

- This minimum grade requirement applies whether taken at RIC or transferred in from another institution.
- If the transfer grade shows as a **T** on your RIC transcript you must contact the Admissions Office to have the letter grade posted to your RIC transfer credit report (or bring a copy of your transcript with the grade posted to Mrs. Grady in HM 105).

Completion of Math Requirement (same as Rhode Island College Mathematics Competency Requirement)

- Contact the Admissions Office if you believe your SAT score has satisfied this requirement.
- Contact Megan DiBonaventura at the Math Learning Center if you believe your CCRI Accuplacer results or your Math 010 grade fulfills this requirement.

First Year Writing with minimum grade of B (Writing 100 with a grade of B is also acceptable)

- This minimum grade requirement applies whether taken at RIC or transferred in from another institution.
- If the transfer grade shows as a **T** on your RIC transcript, contact the Admissions Office to have the letter grade posted to your RIC transfer report; see **FSEHD A-Z (Admissions to FSEHD)** for admissions and writing requirements details.

Program-Specific Requirements

- If you are applying to **Elementary Education, Early Childhood Education, Health Education, or Physical Education**, check the program-specific requirements box to verify that you have successfully completed specific program courses.
- If you are applying to **Secondary Education, Art Education, Music Education, Technology Education, or World Languages Education**, you must go to the Educational Studies Office, HBS 219, before the end of the semester and prior to submitting your application, to initiate the content GPA review.
