

New Requirement for Admission to Feinstein School of Education and Human Development (FSEHD)

Students who submit Admission Portfolios to FSEHD after April 16, 2010 will need to provide evidence of completing WRTG 100 – Writing and Rhetoric with a minimum grade of B. The Career Commitment Essay will no longer be required.

This requirement is waived for second degree, Rhode Island Teacher Education (RITE) and Master of Arts in Teaching (MAT) applicants.

The Phase-in Process for this New FSEHD Admission Requirement

Students who submit Admission Portfolios to FSEHD from August 19, 2009 through April 16, 2010 can either provide evidence of completing WRTG 100 with a minimum grade of B or evidence of completing the Career Commitment Essay with a minimum score of three.

The last dates for submitting a Career Commitment Essay for scoring are:

October 13, 2009

November 17, 2009

February 23, 2010

April 6, 2010
