



DO YOU NEED TO GET READY FOR THE PRAXIS II TESTS?

Announcing an ***Intensive*** Workshop Series for the Praxis II Tests!!

Students admitted to the Feinstein School of Education and Human Development are required to pass the mandated Rhode Island Department of Education Praxis II teacher licensure tests before student teaching in a teacher preparation program at Rhode Island College. These tests are required by the State of Rhode Island in order to be certified to teach. Anxious about taking these tests? Unsure how best to prepare? Already attempted the test (s) and did not pass? Just want to be sure you are doing all you can to get ready? Consider this workshop!

Praxis II tests teacher candidates are required to take and pass are: Elementary Education – 0012 and 0014; Early Childhood Education: 0021 and 0022 **or** 0012 and 0014 **or** 0012 and 0022 **or** 0014 and 0021; Secondary Education – 0524, and Art, Health, Music, Physical Education and Technology Education- 0522 **or** 0524. **This workshop covers ONLY 0012, 0014 and 0522/0524 (PLT)!**
Note: Preparation for 0012, 0014 and PLT occurs in separate break out groups, please choose one exam per workshop session to focus on.

The workshop will consist of activities **over four consecutive days**. Participants will:

Develop a study plan
Learn effective use of the tools and resources available
Review test taking strategies
Practice anxiety reducing strategies
