REQUIREMENTS & PROCESS FOR APPLICATION

Fall Application:

Students who anticipate enrolling in the beginning nursing courses, Nursing 220 and Nursing 222 for the **fall semester** need to submit a completed *Application to Nursing Program: Enrollment Form* by **April 15th** of the preceding spring semester. All admission requirements must be completed by end of the Spring Semester. The cumulative GPA must be 2.7 at the time of application and at the end of the semester in which an application has been submitted.

Spring Application:

Students who anticipate enrolling in the beginning nursing courses, Nursing 220 and Nursing 222 for the **spring semester** need to submit a completed *Application to the Nursing Program: Enrollment Form* by **October 15th** of the preceding fall semester. All admission requirements must be completed by end of the Fall Semester. The cumulative GPA must be 2.7 at the time of application and at the end of the semester in which an application has been submitted.

Admission Requirements for Application:

1. Students must be admitted to Rhode Island College and be a declared Nursing Major.
2. Completion of Rhode Island College Mathematics competency & Writing Requirement. *
3. Completion of Biology 231 (Human Anatomy) with a minimum grade of C.
4. Completion of Psychology 230 (Human Development) with a minimum grade of C.
5. Completion of Chemistry 106 (General, Organic & Biological Chemistry II) with a minimal grade of C.
6. A minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.7.

Application Process:

1. Complete the *Application to Nursing Program: Enrollment Form*. Applications can be obtained in the School of Nursing FLS 145 or on the School of Nursing website www.ric.edu/nursing.
2. All students should attach a student copy of their current Rhode Island College transcript.
3. All students must attach transcripts with grades for all courses taken elsewhere – an official or legible student copy is acceptable.
4. Second Degree Candidates must also attach a copy of their Signed Plan of Study.
5. Second degree candidates who are requesting to take all four of the beginning nursing classes must complete and submit a petition with the application.
6. Make an appointment to meet with your faculty advisor in the School of Nursing and obtain his or her signature with date of application prior to submitting the application to the School of Nursing.
7. Submit the signed and completed application with attached transcripts, or learning plan for second degree candidates, to the administrative secretary, Carol Peck, prior to the **April 15th or October 15th** deadline for applications.
8. **Students MUST attach a current copy of RIC transcript and all transcripts with grades for courses taken elsewhere. Second Degree Candidate must also attach a copy of Signed Plan of Study. If Second Degree Candidates wish to petition to take the four beginning nursing courses, the Petition should also be attached.**
