CUR Members Only Website: This has information on topics such as funding resources and undergraduate research celebration days at institutions across the country. CUR Quarterly Subscription: Once signed up, you'll receive an electronic subscription to CUR Quarterly, a highly regarded journal focusing on topics related to undergraduate research.
