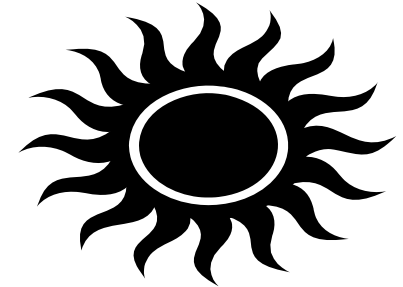

## A National Network

The Young Writers' Summer Institutes, sponsored by the Rhode Island Writing Project, are part of the National Writing Project's network of Youth Writing Projects. Throughout the United States, the Young Writers' Institutes offer students a unique opportunity to learn about the craft of writing by actively participating in all aspects of the writing process.

## An Invitation

Students presently enrolled in grades K-12 are invited to participate in a summer writing community. Five concurrent sessions will be organized by grade levels for the two-week writing program. The program will meet Monday—Friday from 9AM—12PM. Last summer the groups were organized according to the following grades:

K-2      3-4      5-6      7-8      9-12

However, these groupings may change, since the groups are determined by the number of students enrolled in each grade.

## Frequently Asked Questions

### How much does the camp cost?

\$195.00 per child (a limited number of scholarships are available upon request)

### Is this camp for children who write well, or for children who want to become better writers?

This camp is for both fluent and reluctant writers. Students who are fluent writers will have an opportunity to explore and expand their writing and meet peers who also have an interest in writing. Students who are reluctant writers will have an opportunity to explore writing in a lively, interactive community where writing can only be an adventure. Often, reluctant writers develop confidence in such a community.

### Who teaches the students?

Teacher consultants from the Rhode Island Writing Project and faculty from RI College will be teaching the camp.

### How many students are in each class and how are they grouped?

Class size is limited to 20. Students are grouped based on their grade level.

### Is transportation provided?

Unfortunately we do not have the capacity to bus students to the college at this time.

### Do you provide child-care after the camp ends at 12:00 PM?

We do not provide additional day care once the camp ends.
