This major requires completion of a clinical education program leading to certification in Dental Hygiene from an accredited institution. The list below includes the program of study for the Associate in Applied Science Dental Hygiene degree program at the Community College of Rhode Island.

NOTE: The total credit count for Health Science (concentration in Dental Hygiene) major is 94 credits (including courses transferred from CCRI). Six Gen Ed courses will be covered through recommended courses taken at CCRI or program courses at RIC (FYW, FYS, AQSR, M, NS, SB) which leaves 16 more credits of Gen Ed. (A, H, L, and C), and possibly 8 more depending on secondary language needs. The minimum credit count will be 110 credits (without secondary language), which would leave 10 elective credits.
