

APPEAL FOR FINANCIAL AID PROBATIONARY STATUS

The college financial aid policy on satisfactory academic progress allows students who fail to meet the standards to request probationary status on the basis of extenuating circumstances. Probationary status would allow a student to receive financial aid while working to come back into compliance with the standards. Students who have exceeded the 150% limit on attempted credits due to extenuating circumstances may also request probationary status to enable them to complete a degree program. Students appealing for financial aid probationary status must complete all items on this form. The form should be downloaded and completed using MS Word. This will allow the text entries to expand as needed. The form may then be printed and mailed to the Office of Student Financial Aid or e-mailed as an attachment. **The deadline for submission is four weeks prior to the end of the semester in which probationary status is requested.**
