Beneficent Congregational Church Award

Beneficent Congregational Church has established the Beneficent Congregational Church Award to benefit a female nursing student of color at Rhode Island College School of Nursing. This award comes from a fund established at the Church in 1905 for "the education and care of young women."

This monetary award will be offered annually, according to the wishes of the Beneficent Congregational Church, to a female student of color enrolled in the Zvart Onanian School of Nursing; \$3,000 will be awarded for the 2022-2023 academic year. Selection is based on academic performance, service to the department and/or community, and the students must have great financial need as demonstrated by the Office of Financial Aid (FAFSA required).

Selection Criteria

- 1. Applicants must identify as a female nursing student of color.
- 2. Applicants may be either part-time or full-time undergraduate students who have been accepted into the nursing major at Rhode Island College.
- 3. Applicants must have great financial need as determined by the Office of Financial Aid (FAFSA required).
- 4. Applicants must possess an overall cumulative GPA index of at least 3.0
- 5. Applicants must attain at least a 3.0 in each required nursing course.
- 6. Applicants must receive satisfactory clinical evaluations.
- 7. Although the primary emphasis is on scholarly achievement, each applicant should present evidence of department activities and service to the college and community.
- 8. A **signed**, **typewritten statement (no more than 500 words)** about the student's personal philosophy of nursing must be submitted with the application form by email.
