^{*}Starting in Spring 2020, the Metropolitan Tuition Policy (MTP) territory was expanded to include all of New England in addition to the New York City Metropolitan Area; the category was renamed "Northeast Neighbors" (NEN). Therefore, many students who were previously placed in the Out-of-State category are now counted in the MTP/NEN category. This change accounts for some of the decline in the Out-of-State category between 2019 and 2020.

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^{**}Students are placed in schools based on their first majors only. Students with intended majors are included in the school of their intended majors.

^{***}The Computer Information Systems (CIS) program moved from Business to Arts & Sciences; therefore, CIS majors are included in Arts & Sciences as of Fall 2021.
