^{*}The lower number of credits and FTE's for non-degree students in 2022 may be attributed, in part, to the removal of CEU's. In past years, CEU's were included in the credit counts. For most of those years the number of CEU's was very low; however, last year the number increased considerably, and we are now able to disaggregate credits from CEU's. Note: for all years, students enrolled in CEU-based courses are only included in the numbers, if they are also taking at least one credit-based course.

^{**}Starting in Spring 2020, the Metropolitan Tuition Policy (MTP) territory was expanded to include all of New England in addition to the New York City Metropolitan Area; the category was renamed "Northeast Neighbors" (NEN). Therefore, many students who were previously placed in the Out-of-State category are now counted in the MTP/NEN category. This change accounts for some of the decline in the Out-of-State category between 2019 and 2020.

^{***}Students are placed in schools based on their first majors only. Students with intended majors are included in the school of their intended majors.

^{****}The Computer Information Systems (CIS) program has moved from Business to Arts & Sciences; therefore, CIS majors are included in Arts & Sciences in Spring 2021 and Spring 2022.

^{^&}quot;Undeclared" includes only students remaining in the old "Undeclared" category. Students in "Exploring" majors are included their respective schools.
