## Report of the Council Bylaws Committee for 2022-23

Membership: Thomas Schmeling (chair), Maureen Reddy, Kemal Saatcioglu.

The Committee met via Zoom twice, once in each semester. The agendas for the 12/16/22 and 4/27/23 meetings are attached. No formal minutes were taken. The Committee also exchanged emails on committee issues in cases where there the issues were minor or there was not sufficient time to arrange a meeting.

In early December, the committee considered a proposal to change the charge and membership of the Mission and Goals Committee. The proposal was scheduled to be considered by the Council Executive Committee in less than one week and, with insufficient time to convene a meeting, the Committee discussed the proposal in email. Several suggestions were incorporated into the draft and the proposal was returned to the Executive Committee. The by-law was subsequently passed by Council on 12/9/22 and approved by a 2/3 vote of Council at the February meeting.

At our December meeting, the Committee considered and prepared a formal version of a proposal to revise the by-law for the Committee on Online Learning (COOL) and forwarded the same to the Executive Committee. This proposal was passed by Council in March and approved by a 2/3 vote of Council at the April meeting.

The Committee also reviewed a proposed change to the by-law for the Committee on Academic Policies and Procedures (CAPP) which was submitted by the CAPP chair. The Committee produced a formal proposal and sent it back to the CAPP chair for comment, but we did not receive a response until April. The proposal was discussed at our April 27 meeting and was forwarded to the Council Chair with the Committee's comments. No further action has been taken on this proposal as of the time this report was prepared.

The Committee discussed several other issues at the December meeting, as indicated on the attached agenda, but no action was taken on these at that time.

In February, the committee completed a revision of the By-laws to incorporate changes to the yB-Laws that were approved that month. The current on-line version of the By-Laws includes these changes.

In March, a proposal to change the by-law for Academic Standing Committee was submitted by Susan Weiss. The proposal was considered by the By-Laws Committee at our meeting on April 27<sup>th</sup>, and forwarded to the Council Chair with extensive comments and concerns. No further action has been taken on this by-law as of this writing.

As noted last year, the bylaw for the Faculty Research Committee remains out of date and essentially inoperative since the latest the Faculty Contract creates a different Faculty Research Committee that overlaps the Council Committee but whose membership and bylaws are unclear. Several individuals and groups attempted to reconcile the different provisions but were unable to do so. It was eventually determined that the soundest course was to revise and clarify the Contract provisions themselves. We hoped that will happen in 2022-23. However, as of May 2, 2023, the Contract has not been ratified.

Several other issues remain the probably deserve attention. As indicated in the agenda for 12/16/222, he status of COGE should be clarified. If the Student Conduct Board has been replaced by another committee, its by-law should be formally repealed and the committee abolished.
