Enrollment Summary:

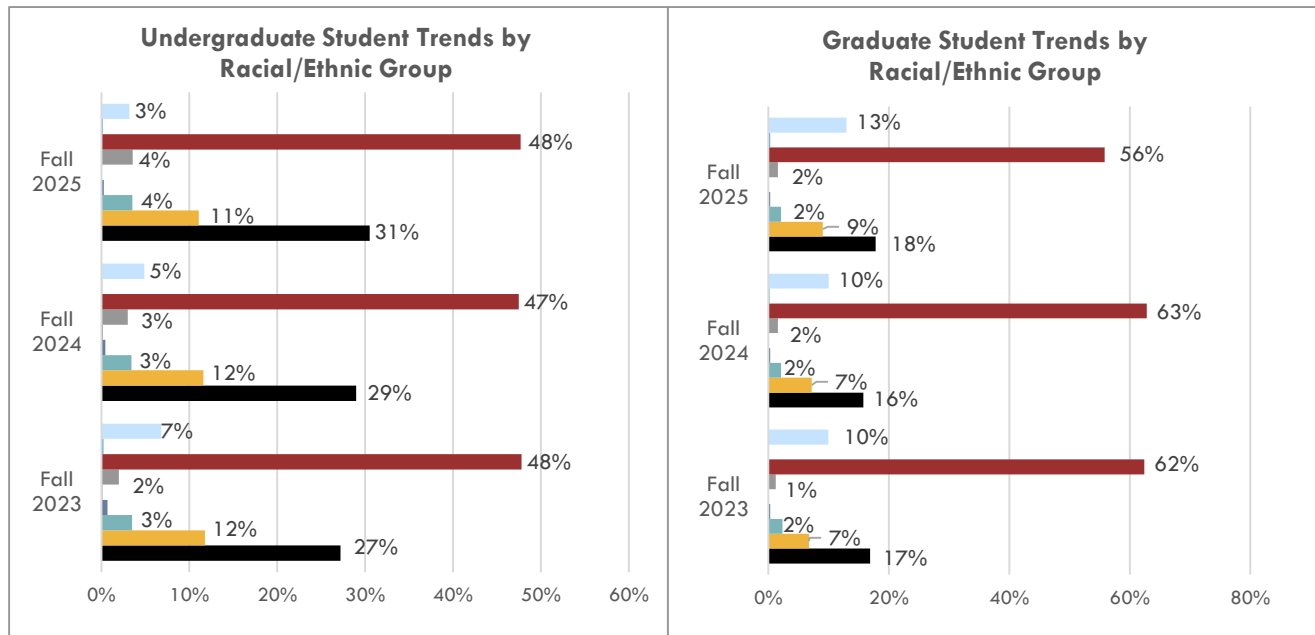
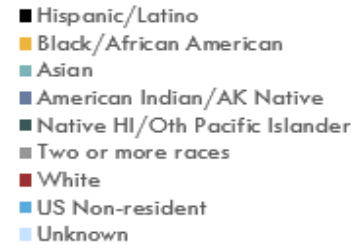
RIC's overall headcount is up for the second-straight year, growing by over 400 students compared to Fall 2023. There were increases in both the first-time, full-time and new transfer student populations, as well as an increase in the number of students electing to live on campus.

The percentage of students identifying as people of color and first-generation increased, though the percentage of Pell Grant-eligible students declined slightly.
