Horace Mann Hall

Built in 1971, Horace Mann Hall originally housed Professional Studies. Now home to the Feinstein School of Education and Human Development (FSEHD), the renovation included major improvements including a wing featuring six classrooms and three seminar rooms; bright and spacious student common areas; a three-story addition for offices; new roof, elevator, and windows. The renovation also included electrical, plumbing and network technology upgrades.

Departments housed within Horace Mann are Educational Studies, Elementary Education, Special Education and Counseling, Educational Leadership, and School Psychology.

Horace Mann (1796-1859), known as the Father of the Common School, began his career as a lawyer and legislator. The principles that Mann developed lead to the development of "normal schools," which specifically trained the "norms" of teaching. This included the Rhode Island Normal School*, located on Weybosset Street in Providence, which opened its doors on May 29, 1854. *Now known as Rhode Island College.

Horace Mann Hall was reopened in the spring of 2023 following a 3-year renovation.
