

How to Register for New Student Orientation

Step 1: Go to www.my.ric.edu and login using your RIC ID and Password. This information was provided to you when you deposited in an email sent to the personal email address you provided when apply to RIC.

***Please Note*:** If you deposited during normal business hours (Monday-Friday, 8:30am –4:30 pm) an email should be sent to your personal email the following day. **It may take up to 48 hours for your information to be updated in the system. Please allow for this time before attempting to register for New Student Orientation. Information is not processed on Saturday, Sunday, or Holidays.**

Select a session: Please choose an online orientation session from the dates listed in the drop down on the registration page. If you do not see a drop-down list, please click the magnifying glass icon under select a session to show the drop down. 

Orientation will be a combination of Synchronous (at a set time via ZOOM) and Asynchronous (on your own time online) sessions. When selecting a session, you will see the date for your Synchronous session (sessions listed below). This is the date that you will be expected to attend Orientation register for classes. Once you register for Orientation you will receive instructions to access New Student Orientation Online Modules via Blackboard within a few days of registering for a session. This is the Asynchronous portion of the Orientation program. It is required that you complete these Online Orientation Modules prior to your August session to prepare you for your class registration. COVID-19 In-Person Requirements: Students planning to attend an in-person Orientation session on August 11th or 13th are required to be vaccinated. Students who are fully vaccinated should upload their vaccination documents via Medicat Portal here: <https://ric.medicatconnect.com/login.aspx> or email to healthservices@ric.edu. Students with just one dose of the vaccine by their Orientation date must show proof of a negative COVID-19 test and wear a mask for the entire in-person Orientation. If you do not upload your vaccination documents before your Orientation date, you will be asked to provide the appropriate documentation at check-in, or will not be allowed to attend the in-person session. If you do not want to attend an in-person session or have a vaccine exemption on file with the college, please select the August 27th virtual session.

The email address provided will be used to share this information. It is not required to add any Family/Parent names and is optional for students.

If the personal email address listed on the registration page is incorrect, please change this BEFORE registering by going to: <https://my.ric.edu/> > Personal Contact Info (on left side list under "Student Center") > Email Addresses (in top navigation) > Home (change email next to this title)> Click "SAVE". If you do not change before registering you will not receive the confirmation email before registration the confirmation will be sent to your old email address and cannot be re-sent. All future communications regarding Online New Student Orientation will also be sent to your @ric.edu email address.**
