

PRESIDENT'S ADVISORY BOARD ON PUBLIC ART AND CAMPUS BEAUTIFICATION

Mission, Goals, and Procedures

Central to the mission of the President's Advisory Board on Public Art and Campus Beautification is to promote the display and diversity of art on the Rhode Island College campus, in both interior and exterior locations. Placement of such art work will seek to add to the aesthetic and educational environment on campus. Good art can be provocative or stimulating as well as beautiful or tranquil. The second and equally important mission of the Board will be to provide suggestions, proposals, and support to ongoing efforts to make Rhode Island College an attractive, clean, and tranquil campus for its students, alumni, visitors, faculty, staff, and administrators.

Membership: Members of the Board are appointed by the President. Members are to be chosen from a broad range of the campus community. While not limited to the following, it is suggested that representation shall be given to the Art Department, Bannister Gallery, Performing and Fine Arts Commission, Athletics Department, Facilities & Operations Department, and that both the undergraduate and graduate student population should be represented. In addition, the President will appoint a member from the President's Executive Cabinet (P.E.C.) to serve. This insures a wide perspective on proposals relating to public art and campus beautification. Each member will serve a minimum of two years (with exception to student representatives whom will serve annually) in a rotation of service to provide for continuity of work. The chair shall be elected from this group and shall serve a two year term and can be re-elected without restrictions.

Acceptance of Suggestions and Proposals: Any Board member may bring suggestions and proposals to the attention of the Board. Any member of the Board may receive suggestions from the campus community. All suggestions shall be emailed to all members of the Board within a reasonable time frame and discussed in future meetings of the Board.

Review of Suggestions and Proposals: All suggestions and proposals shall be reviewed by the board at the meeting following the suggestion or proposal. Meetings of the board are to be held monthly during the fall and spring semesters. Recommendations related to routine maintenance may be forwarded directly to the appropriate department, with a copy to the President and appropriate Vice President. Ideas, suggestions, and proposals that are reviewed and recommended by the board will be forwarded each semester via the representative from the P.E.C. for consideration by the P.E.C. and the President.

Revisit of Installations and Campus Art: The Board will revisit campus installations and art on a two-to-five year cycle from the date of installation.

Meeting Minutes: Minutes of board meetings will be taken as designated by the board and forwarded to board members within one week after the meeting. After approval, a copy will be sent to the President.
