

Official Census Enrollment Report Three-Year Trends Spring 2023 - Spring 2025

Enrollment Summary:


Spring 2025 enrollment is up 550 students from Spring 2024's enrollment. This increase is larger than the fall year-over-year increase, driven in part by a rise in the fall-to-spring retention for first-year undergraduates. The number of spring first-time, full-time students remains flat compared to Spring 2024, but there was an increase in new transfers.




