**Enrollment Summary:**

RIC's Spring 2026 enrollment is up 591 (10%) students from Spring 2025. While the graduate student headcount decreased by 74 (7.3%), the undergraduate headcount increased by 665 (13.5%).

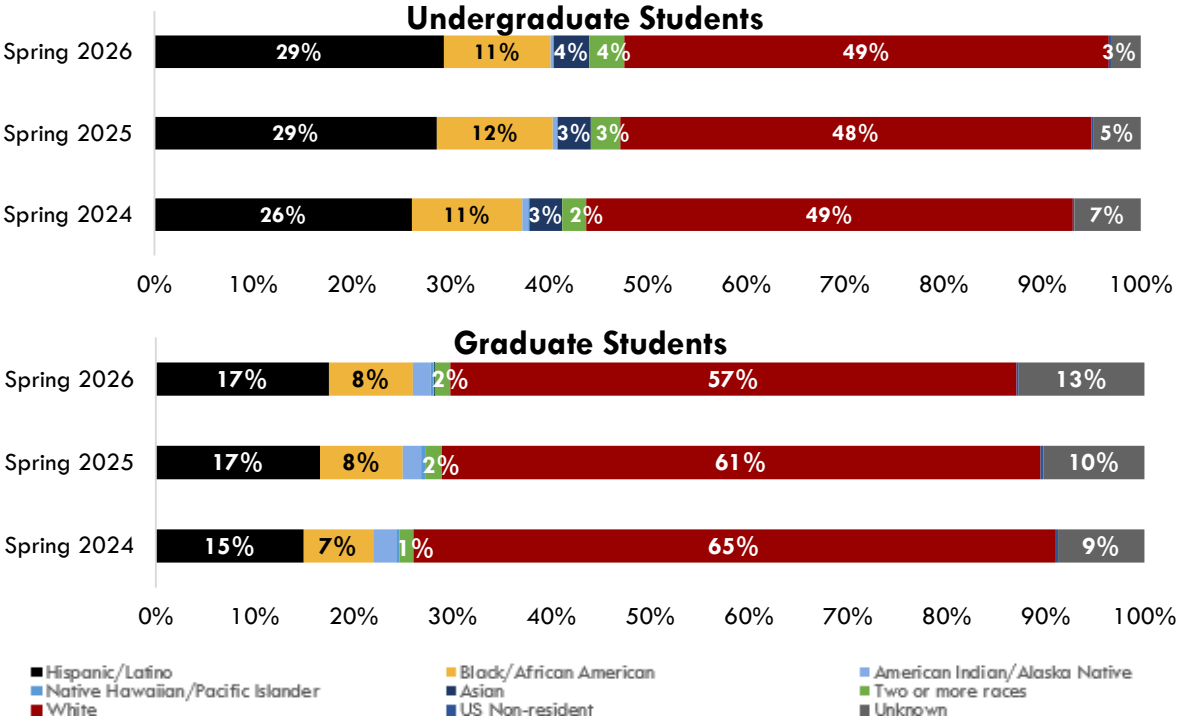
Returning students account for 95% of the Spring 2026 undergraduate population a 3 percentage point increase from 92% last spring.
