
How to Register for New Student Orientation


Step 1: Go to www.my.ric.edu and login using your RIC ID and Password. This information was provided to you when you deposited in an email sent to the personal email address you provided when apply to RIC.

Please Note: If you deposited during normal business hours (Monday-Friday, 8:30am –4:30 pm) an email should be sent to your personal email the following day. It may take up to 48 hours for your information to be updated in the system. Please allow for this time before attempting to register for New Student Orientation. Information is not processed on Saturday, Sunday, or Holidays.

Step 3: Complete Registration Information:

Please use this page to register for an Online Orientation Session. The information you provide on this page will be used for orientation purposes only.

Select a session: Please choose an online orientation session from the dates listed in the drop down on the registration page. If you do not see a drop-down list, please click the magnifying glass icon under select a session to show the drop down.

Orientation will be a combination of Synchronous (at a set time via ZOOM) and Asynchronous (on your own time online) sessions. When selecting a session, you will see TWO dates for each session (sessions listed below). These dates are the Synchronous Opening and Closing sessions for the program. Students are required to attend both sessions at the times listed to complete orientation and register for classes. When selecting a session please make sure you are available for BOTH dates and times listed. You are unable to mix dates. If you have any questions, please contact orientation@ric.edu. Information about how to access these sessions will be sent to your RIC email 1 week before your Opening Session.
